

Is This Poland's Future in the EU: The Masters of Auschwitz Are Coming Back

The people of Poland currently have to take an important decision: do they want to be part of a European Union that is dominated by a few economic powers or is the scepticism about this form of Europe of "big business" justified.

The purpose of this page is to provide some important historical facts to this debate. It will show that it is not only the people of Poland who should be highly sceptical of this monster - but the people all over Europe.



Historical Facts

WWII was planned and financed by the world's largest chemical/pharmaceutical cartel at that time, Germany's IG Farben (Bayer, BASF, Hoechst and others). Their goal was to conquer Europe and unite it as a common market for their chemical and petrochemical products. The only way to accomplish this goal was by military force, so they brought the Nazis into power as their political and military agents. The details of this master plan can be obtained from the records of the Nuremberg War Crime Tribunal against IG Farben that have just been published online for the first time (www.profit-over-life.org).

The Roots of the European Union

After the military attempt to conquer Europe had failed, the interests around this oil and drug cartel regrouped. While the political and military stakeholders of the IG Farben/Nazi coalition received heavy sentences in Nuremberg, the IG Farben executives - the real war criminals - were soon reinstated in the highest positions of the IG Farben successors, namely BASF and Bayer. Their goal was to make a second attempt at the "conquest" of Europe - this time using political pressure and economic bribery in the context of forging an EU ruled by large corporations.

Not surprisingly, the political architects of the European Union were all relicts of the Nazi era or successors of IG Farben interests. Walter Hallstein, a leading law professor in Nazi Germany, was imposed as the first President of the European Commission from 1956 - 1967. His task was to design the basic legal framework of the EU to assure corporate control at every level.

Under the two-decade long reign of German Chancellor Helmut Kohl - who had risen from the ranks of an employee of the IG Farben daughter BASF to the Chancellery - the political institutions of the EU were shaped according to the demands of multi-national corporations. Under Kohl's reign, the so-called "European Commission" was turned into the politburo of the oil and drug cartel - elected by no-one and operating beyond any democratic control. It was the oil and drug cartel that financed the EU as its operative basis.

Lessons From History

- 1933 IG Farben finances the Nazi rise to power.
- 1939 IG Farben takes over the chemical and petrochemical industry in Poland.
- 1940 IG Farben builds giant IG Auschwitz plant with Polish forced labour; opponents of this regime perish in the Auschwitz concentration camp
- 1948 IG Farben executives sentenced in Nuremberg for genocide and slavery - particularly for the crimes committed in Auschwitz and other parts of Poland.
- 1951 Hans Globke, co-author of the Commentary to the Nuremberg racial laws, escaped the Nuremberg Tribunal and - as head of the Chancellery office - became the key architect of post-war Germany. Under his term of office, each of the three IG Farben successor companies, Bayer, BASF and Hoechst became more powerful than the parent ever was.
- 1952 Carl Wurster, during WWII chairman of the chemical company that produced the zyklon B gas for Auschwitz and indicted in the Nuremberg War Crimes Tribunal, becomes head of BASF for thirteen years.
- 1956 Fritz Ter Meer, sentenced in Nuremberg for genocide and slavery in connection with the crimes in Auschwitz, becomes chairman of the supervisory board of Bayer for almost a decade.
- 1958 Walter Hallstein, a leading Nazi lawyer, becomes the first President of the European Commission for a full decade.
- 1960s While Wurster is still head of BASF, he discovers a promising young employee, Helmut Kohl, and promotes his political ascent right up to the Chancellery of Germany.
- 1981-98 For 16 years, Helmut Kohl is the political conductor for the oil and drug cartel, finances the built-up of the EU bureaucracy, and organises its second attempt to take over Europe. During his reign, he names two reliable successors who would continue guiding Europe into the hands of big business: Angela Merkel and Wolfgang Schaeuble, today's most worthy executors of this task.
